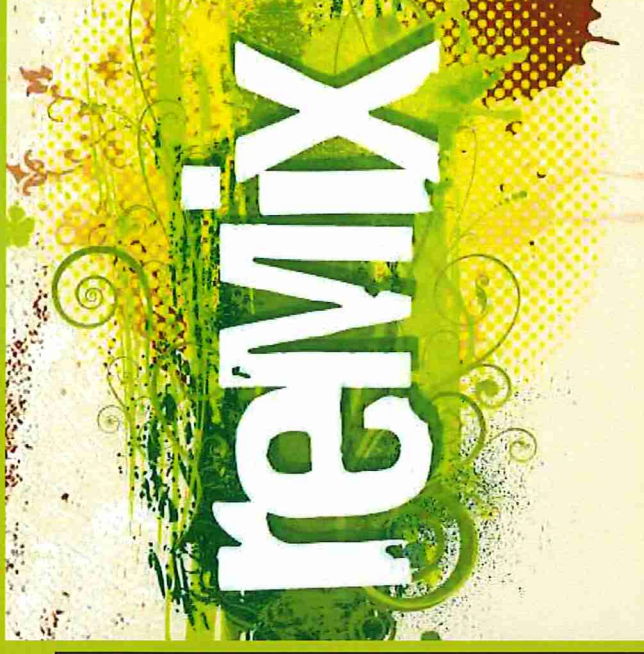

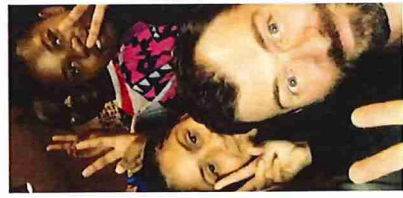
OUR SPEAKER: PASTOR MATT KEADLE
